

# All Laser LASIK Frequently Asked Questions

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## What is All Laser LASIK?

The All Laser method refers to a more personalized approach to laser vision correction. The revolutionary procedure offered at Harman Eye Center uses the latest laser technologies, including the VICTUS Femtosecond laser for an innovative procedure called All Laser LASIK. The entire procedure is blade-free! This method adds a new level of precision and safety, while increasing the possibility of vision even better than 20/20.

Dr. Harman performs LASIK procedures at the Harman Eye Surgery Center; equipped with the latest technology and staffed by a highly trained team focused on your care and comfort.

## Why should I consider All Laser LASIK?

All Laser LASIK vision correction at Harman Eye Center enables you to improve your vision and your quality of life. You are in good hands – David M. Harman, M.D. is a very experienced eye surgeon and has performed thousands of refractive surgeries and LASIK procedures since 1993. We are here to answer any questions you may have.

## How do I prepare?

We offer patients the option for a free personalized consultation to determine eligibility for LASIK surgery. The next step is a pre-operative dilated eye exam including testing to make sure your eyes are healthy and to confirm that you are a candidate for LASIK. If you are a contact lens wearer, you will need to keep your contacts out prior to that exam so that we can accurately measure your cornea. We recommend at least 2 weeks for soft contacts and 4 weeks for hard contacts.

All of your testing and exam results will be reviewed with you at that appointment. If you are a candidate and wish to proceed, you may reserve your surgery date with a \$150.00 nonrefundable fee. This fee will be deducted from your balance due the day of your procedure.

## Day of Surgery

Please plan to have someone drive you home after your procedure. The procedure itself will take about 10 minutes per eye; however, you will be at the office for about 2 hours so that we can prepare your eye for the surgery.

## Should I expect any pain?

Your eye will be numbed with a topical anesthetic prior to surgery for maximum comfort. Patients generally experience little to no pain during the surgery. Following the procedure, it's possible that you will experience some mild irritation, such as the feeling of an eyelash in your eye. To make your eyes more comfortable, we will give you antibiotic drops as well as artificial tears in your post-operative kit. After surgery plan to rest your eyes to help the healing process.

## Let's talk pricing.

The cost for All Laser LASIK is \$2,100.00 per eye. Please ask for a special discount if you are a PCHP member, police officer, fire fighter, EMS, or in the military. Within the cost, we include your post-operative kit, post-operative visits within one year and any retreatment within one year. Retreatments after one year are \$1,000.00 per eye. "No interest" financing is available through the CareCredit program. Pricing is subject to change.
